In 2009, architect **Peter Rich** won the World Building of the Year award for his Mapungubwe Interpretation Centre and we are greatly privileged to have Professor Rich explain how he has studied village communities and structures in parts of Africa and how these have in turn influenced his design of buildings such as the Alexander Community Centre and his own home in Parktown, culminating in the Mapungubwe Interpretation Centre.

While Africa is his first love, he has recently designed **STONE HOUSE - UPSTREAM HOTEL** in Anji, Zhejiang, China once again demonstrating respect for the local culture and particularly the setting and the environment.
